### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY :**

#### **ONLY REGISTERED CLYDESDALE HORSES CAN COMPETE**

- **No entries on the day - strictly online by closing date.**
- No refunds will be given for classes missed.
- No refunds will be given after the closing date Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.
- All stallions and colts to be handled by competent handlers.
- Horses to be registered & exhibitors to be a current financial member of the CCHSA to be eligible to compete in all classes.
- Proof of registration to be produced if the CCHSA Victoria Branch requests.
- No other animal or livestock other than horses are permitted in the ring.
- All instructions from stewards and nominated officials are obeyed at all times.
- Officials have the power to disqualify or remove competitors if instructions are not obeyed.
- Any competitor removed from competition may also have prize money withheld.
- All harness vehicles and equipment used at the event are in sound and safe condition.
- All horses at the event are kept under proper control at all times.
- All horses in ridden and driven sections must be bitted (no bitless bridles accepted).
- All horses being driven in harness *must* wear blinkers.
- Covered footwear must be worn at all times in marshalling and competition areas and all competitors must be appropriately dressed for the event entered.
- Helmets to be worn in ridden classes and must comply to Australian Standards.
- Junior handlers/riders/drivers under 12 years of age must wear a helmet that complies to Australian Standards.
- Judges and stewards decision is final.

### **Liability**

- All competitors are to sign an indemnity form prior to competing.
- All competitors acknowledge and agree as a condition of participating that neither the CCHSA (Vic Branch), members, competitors, participants, officials, volunteers, medical personnel, and persons, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, shall not be held liable for my death bodily injury, loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me, as a result of my participation in or present at the event, except in regard to any rights I may have arising under the Trade Practices Act 1974.

**Competitors acknowledge that equestrian activities are dangerous and that accidents causing death, bodily injury, disability and property damage, can and do happen. Competitors accept this responsibility on behalf of their horse handlers, employees and servants.**

- This form is compulsory for all persons attending any Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society Victoria Branch activity. This includes competitors, grooms and volunteers (necessary to run the activity).
- Persons who are not required to run the event shall not be allowed on the grounds or venue of the activity. i.e. spectators, unnecessary family members and friends, etc.(subject to change to State/Territory laws)
- The form is to be completed on the day of the activity, not prior to the activity, so that up-to-date information is sourced from people attending the activity.
- Members are also required to comply with the laws of the relevant State/Territory.
- Social distancing of a minimum of 1.5 metres is to be observed.
- Reducing the spread – no handshaking, no spitting or clearing of nasal passages, no food or beverages to be shared.

The Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society Australia and the (State Branch together with “the Suppliers”) advise that participation in horse sports at CCHSA events or horse competitions that contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

**By signing this waiver, I acknowledge that:**

- 1.1 participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
  - 1.2 participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
  - 1.3 horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
  - 1.4 if held at an agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses;
  - 1.5 as the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
  - 1.6 insects or other animals may cause my horse or other horses to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
  - 1.7 there is inherent in horse riding events the risk of suffering injury including falling from my horse;
  - 1.8 I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safely and properly participating in the event; and
  - 1.9 I use the facilities entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
1. If I suffer harm while participating in a horse event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any injuries I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided.
  2. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the horse sports and associated activities are a danger and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur and I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in regard to their negligence, breach of statutory duty or statutory guarantees arising from or in connection with these activities to the fullest extent permitted by law.
  3. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
  4. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society (Victoria Branch) as varied from time to time.
