Rules and Regulations

- All horses entered must be registered with the AHSA Ltd
- All entries must be completed online at nominate.com.au
- Stables to be booked directly through Werribee Park Equestrian Centre
- There will be no refund of entry monies under any circumstances
- VADOBA will follow it's own rules registered with CAV. Should there not be a rule, then the VADOBA Model Rules will apply.
- VADOBA will not accept any abusive language or bad behavior from any person on the showgrounds. Any instance of bad behavior or abuse should be reported to the show secretary immediately. Offenders will be dealt with by the discretion of the committee
- VADOBA reserves the right to alter/combine/add or delete any classes
- VADOBA can change the running order or days of classes if thought essential prior to the show all exhibitors will be notified
- Exhibitors /competitors enter entirely at their own risk. If any exhibit, whilst on the showgrounds, shall cause or be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit, exhibitor or the general public, the owner of such animal shall indemnify the club, its officials and members, from and against all damages, costs, claims, expenses or liabilities incurred
- Minors (under the age of 18 yrs old) must be supervised by an adult at all times
- Personal Liability all competitors/strappers/handlers must ensure they have adequate Personal Liability insurance for this event
- No protest shall be entertained, unless in writing and lodged with the show secretary, within 1 hour of the judgement in dispute, and accompanied by a \$50 fee, which will be forfeited should the complaint be thought frivolous. All decisions of the disputes panel shall be final and binding
- The judge's decision is binding
- This is a Championship Show every class will offer Champion/Reserve Champion and Top 5
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are at the ring ready for their class 5 minutes before the start time. Rings will not
 allow horses to enter the ring late unless horse has been marshalled and is in another ring. Rings WILL NOT be held for
 owners/handlers/riders not having horses at the ring and ready on time
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- All ridden exhibits must be a minimum of 3 years of age
- The age of a horse is taken from the 01 August
- The age of a rider in youth classes is taken from the day of the show
- No stallions or colts are to be handled by anyone under the age of 18 years of age
- Non Pro classes The definition of a Non Pro for the VADOBA show is a person who, regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or
 accomplishments, in the past three years has not directly or indirectly accepted payment, goods or money, for services usually
 provided by a professional in the areas of breaking/riding / training / schooling / or showing in hand or under saddle.
- NPTH Non Pro to Handle. NPTR Non Pro to Ride
- Novice ridden / led A novice horse may not have won a first or champion/reserve at any show or open hack show in any class at closing date of entries. If novice saddle class, then exhibit is to be ridden in a snaffle bit.
- Intermediate an Intermediate horse may not have won a first or champion/reserve at any show in any intermediate or open class at closing date of entries snaffle or double bridles permitted.
- Horses in newcomer and novice classes must be shown in a snaffle.
- Newcomer horses cannot have competed under saddle at any competition other than racing prior to the 01/01/2025
- Youth classes all youth must wear short Jodhpur boots in any youth class. Whilst riding all youth under the age of 18 yrs must wear a safety approved helmet.
- All horses must be kept under control at all times. Any horse deemed out of control or dangerous may be excused from the ring
- In order to compete, exhibits must not, in the opinion of the judge, exhibit any lameness. In all events, the judge's decision is final
- VADOBA won't tolerate any actions which affect the welfare of a horse. Such actions include, but are not limited to whipping, excessive shanking, striking, gingering etc. Any horse showing evidence of any inappropriate actions shall be disqualified & prohibited from showing.
- Judging in all classes will be judged comparatively by three judges.
- As per EA guidelines, a horse's sensory hairs may not be clipped and/or shaven or otherwise modified in any way under penalty of
 elimination from the event. Individual sensory hairs may be removed by a veterinarian to prevent pain or discomfort for the Horse.
 Areas of hair that must be clipped, shaven or removed to allow veterinary treatment are exempt from this rule (eg a patch or small
 area of hair removed). A Veterinary Certificate must be presented to Committee on request. Horses found competing with
 clipped/shaven/otherwise modified sensory hairs will be eliminated from the event.
- VADOBA will be following the EA Child Safeguarding Policy. Where there is any discrepancy or something not covered, we will be
 following the regulations as published on the vic.gov website. Volunteers, committee and coaches will be required to provide
 VADOBA with a WWC prior to the show. Coaches are defined on vic.gov.au as those who provide private tuition services of any kind
 specifically for children. All EA accredited coaches must have a WWC.
